YABT Activities Summary

2024

In 2024, the Young Americas Business Trust (YABT) reaffirmed its commitment to empowering youth across the Americas through innovative programs, strategic partnerships, and impactful initiatives.

This document outlines the activities carried out by YABT, from organizing high-level forums and competitions to fostering collaboration with governments, international organizations, and the private sector. Through these efforts, YABT has further solidified its role as a catalyst for youth-led innovation and transformative change.

BootCamp sessions

The Young Americas Business Trust (YABT) conducted 19 virtual training sessions focused on entrepreneurship, sustainability, and socioeconomic inclusion, benefiting over 500 young entrepreneurs.

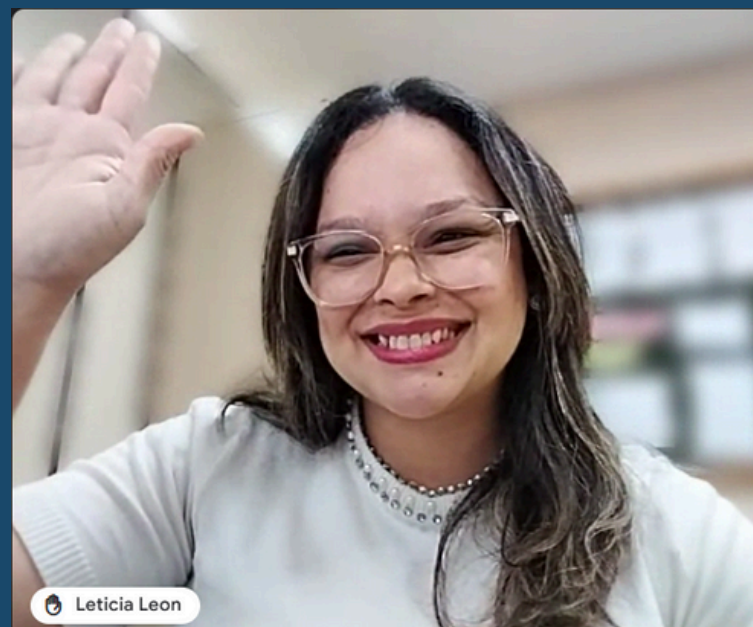


Conference: Innovative Entrepreneurship and International Opportunities

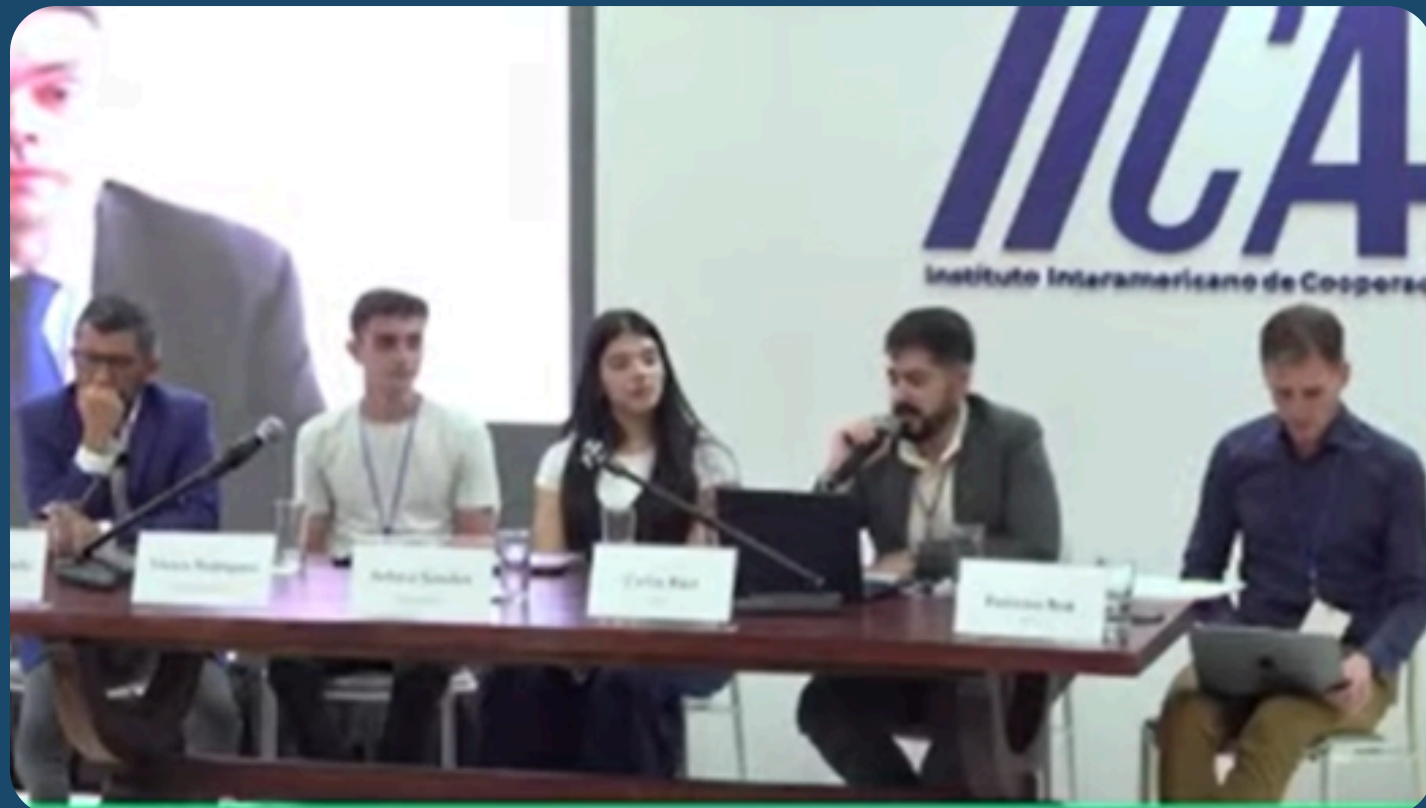




Bridging Dialogues: Key Recommendations for EU-CELAC and Americas Summits (New York)

YABT was invited as a pioneering organization in youth entrepreneurship at the official SOTF Action Day side event, titled “Pact for the Future and Beyond: Towards the 4th International Conference on Financing for Development,” hosted by the Club de Madrid (CdM) at the United Nations Headquarters.

The event convened key stakeholders, including UN Under-Secretary Generals, to evaluate progress on financial reforms and development financing, with a focus on aligning global efforts to advance the 2030 Agenda.
